**Learn Welsh on our Summer Course
21 - 25 June 2010**

The University is located in the heart of Welsh speaking Wales, providing learners with ample opportunity to practise the language. Where better to learn Welsh? Come to Lampeter to learn Welsh quickly, in a relaxed atmosphere with the help of experienced Welsh language tutors.

You will get a full understanding of the language, its grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation patterns. There will be an emphasis on developing your communicative effectiveness, so you will increase your confidence, fluency and ability to use the language outside the classroom. Small classes ensure a high level of individual attention with emphasis given to pair and group work. We try to make the learning experience fun and challenging at all times, to motivate you to work hard and get results! You will be in a group of students who share the same goal of wanting to achieve fluency and success in Welsh.

We have computer facilities for individuals staying on campus and the University Library is available during normal opening hours for study purposes. Become part of a friendly, demanding, but enjoyable study environment - the perfect way to learn Welsh!

What level will I have reached by the end of the course?

The committed learner with no previous knowledge of the language should be able to hold a basic conversation with a sympathetic first-language speaker by the end of the course. The course provides the experienced learner with an ideal springboard to complete fluency. This course is an accredited university course and 20 credits are awarded on successful completion. The course will give you a firm foundation for further study and language acquisition.

What levels are available?

The following levels are normally available subject to the number of students attending:

- Level 1: Mynediad.** This level is suitable for individuals with no previous knowledge of the language. Great emphasis is given to spoken Welsh.
- Level 2: Sylfaen.** The aim of this level is to extend the speaking skills of the learner. It is suitable for those who understand a little Welsh, or have completed the Cwrs Mynediad or Wlpan 1.
- Level 3: Canolradd.** This level is for relatively confident Welsh learners who have completed the Cwrs Sylfaen or Wlpan. Emphasis is given to spoken Welsh but the lessons will also aim to develop writing, reading and listening skills.
- Level 4: Uwch.** This level is for learners who are fairly fluent in Welsh. The lessons will aim to continue development of oral skills and encourage further writing in Welsh.
- Level 5: Hyfedredd.** Mae'r lefel hon ar gyfer y rheiny sydd i bob pwrpas yn rhugl eu Cymraeg, neu'n gwneud y cymhwyster 'Defnyddio Cym Uwch'.

When applying to attend the course, please specify in detail how much Welsh you have already studied, in order for you to be placed in the correct class on the first day.

How much will the course cost?

Price: The course fee is **£538.00**. Automatic bursaries are available for UK and EU residents who are self-funding. This will reduce the actual cost to **£150.00**.
